THERE WERE 7 FIRST PRIZE 5TH GRADE WINNERS. THREE OF THEM WERE AT WINSTON PARK!





Ava Marion made flowers out of bottle caps. No need to water!


THERE WERE 8 RUNNER UP PRIZES IN BROWARD COUNTY, 5 CAME FROM WINSTON PARK!
