As the proud principal of Plantation, I would like to express my gratitude to all who have contributed to our success this past school year. We are excited for another great year at Plantation. First day of school is Wednesday, August 15th, 2018 and students should be seated in class by 7:40am.

One of our new innovative programs at our school is the Gifted Academy. The program will consist of gifted 9th graders who will participate in a highly engaging and challenging academic learning environment.

Another new program this year is International Colonel Academy which will provide individualized learning for English Language Learners. The aim is to help these students develop communicative and academic skills necessary for meeting national, state, and district educational standards in a small group setting.

Safety and security procedural changes:

- All staff and students are required to wear their ID badges at all times.
- The East parking lot (Sunrise Blvd and 16th St) will open at 6:45 am and close at 7:15 am each morning and close at 3:00 pm each afternoon.
- Students should be dropped off at the parent loop on 70th Ave starting at 7:00 am (no student should be dropped off in the front of the school).
- The student parking lot on 70th Ave will open at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 am.
- If students are late to school more than 3 times per quarter, their parking privileges will be taken away.
- Students should be picked up no later than 3:15 pm due to adult supervision ending at that time.
- The Welcome Center office hours are from 7am – 3pm.

Student schedules are currently available in Pinnacle and Virtual Counselor. First period locators will be available in multiple locations on campus on the first day of school. Students will be provided with a copy of their schedule in their first period class.

Student arrivals after 7:40 am, without a parent, will receive a detention through the Welcome Center. Detentions are served Monday – Thursday from 2:50 pm - 3:50 pm.

One of our new practices at Plantation High School is the "SEE SOMETHING SAY SOMETHING" initiative which encourages individuals to help protect our campus through awareness.

I am pleased to welcome 2 new additions to my administrative staff: 9th grade Assistant Principal, Mrs. Nichola Stephenson-Gayle and 10th grade Assistant Principal, Mr. Jonathan Edwards. I look forward to working with them in the upcoming year.
