

FSA is Coming!

The Florida Standards Assessment (FSA), as adopted by the State Board of Education, focuses on analytical thinking to prepare Florida students for success in college, career, and life. Broward County Schools administers the BSA (Broward Standard Assessment) to students in January after the winter break to better prepare them for FSA assessment in the spring. This assessment provides an authentic assessment of the Florida Standards in order to determine where students are academically and to assist them in moving them to where they may need to be to ensure FSA success. Students must be present and ready to test during the BSA administration in order to be adequately prepared for the FSA. The administration windows for the BSA and FSA are listed below. Please ensure that your child gets enough sleep, eats a nutritious breakfast, and attends all scheduled tests.

SCIENCE Updates

An amazing real-world application that can be applied for all 6th, 7th and 8th-grade students is percentages. Ask your child if there is an item they would like to have, can they find a discount, do they know how much money will be saved by having a percent taking off the total amount.

Cooking is another great concept that helps with the understanding of fractions. Suggestion: Have your child make a recipe and then had them increase the ingredients, would they know how much of each item would be needed? All great real-world life applications.
