INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Our school has adopted The "I Love U Guys" Foundation's Standard Response Protocol (SRP). Students and staff will be training, practicing, and drilling the protocol.

COMMON LANGUAGE

The Standard Response Protocol (SRP) is based on an allhazards approach as opposed to individual scenarios. Like the Incident Command System (ICS), SRP utilizes clear common language while allowing for flexibility in protocol.

The premise is simple - there are five specific actions that can be performed during an incident. When communicating these, the action is labeled with a "Term of Art" and is then followed by a "Directive." Execution of the action is performed by active participants, including students, staff, teachers and first responders. The SRP is based on the following actions: Hold, Secure, Lockdown, Evacuate, and




FortifyFL is a suspicious activity reporting tool that allows you to instantly relay information to appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.

Uniform Information - In School Only

Silver Lakes Middle is a unified uniform school. Students must adhere to the uniform policy daily.

Shirts: COLLARED shirts in solid colors - blue, black, grey, white and green ONLY. No logos or patterns are permitted.

Pants/Skirts/Shorts: Navy Blue, Black, Khaki or Gray. No Jeans will be allowed this year. NO JEANS or SHORTS/SKIRTS.

*Students may wear solid colored sweat jackets without hoodies. For safety reasons, hoodies/head gear and slides are not permitted to be worn during the school day. Earbuds must be worn with one ear open to hear directions and announcements. (safety first!)
