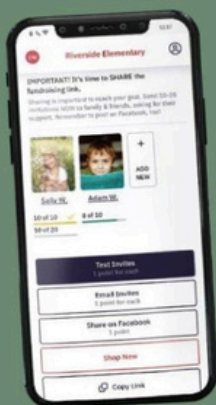

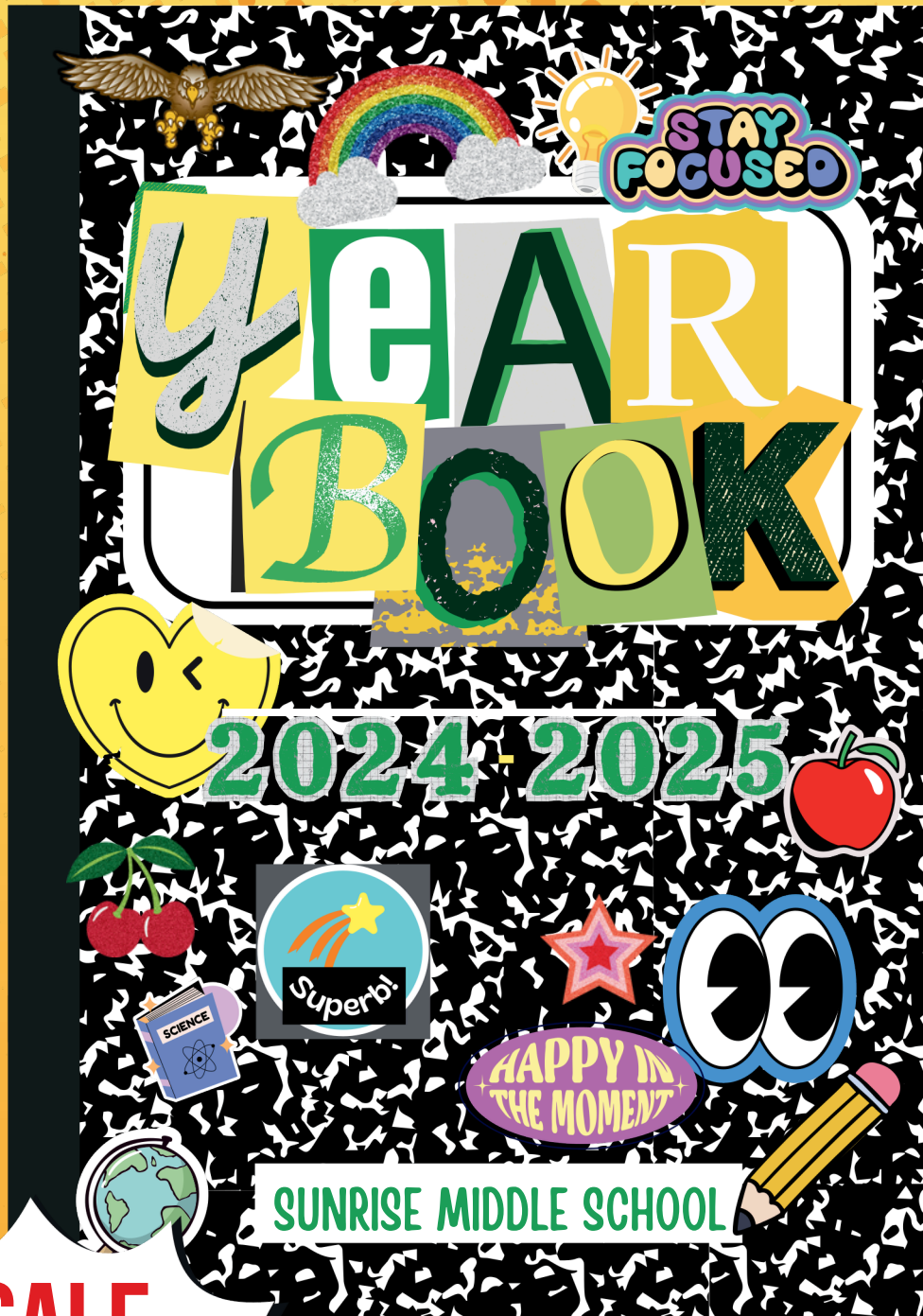

## Accessing Educational Records (FOCUS)

The Focus Parent Portal is your gateway to staying connected with your child's educational journey. Focus is replacing Pinnacle, Virtual Counselor, and EdPlan. For the first time, parents/guardians with multiple children will be able to access all of their educational records in one place. **CLICK HERE** for more information and to register to access:

- Back to School forms
- View transportation/bus information
- View student class schedule
- View student grades (teachers will add grades within the first few weeks of school)

**When parents access the Parent Portal, a message will open for them to complete the Back-to-School Re-Enrollment Forms. Once these are filled out and submitted, parents will be able to access student schedules and other items in the Parent Portal.**
