#### **Schedule Information**

Schedules will be available on Virtual Counselor on August 18, 2023. Students who are unable to access their schedule on Virtual Counselor may pick up their schedules on the first day of school in the Media Center at 9:15 a.m.

# **Schedule Change Policy**

Nova Middle School creates student schedules with careful consideration to each student's academic level and areas of interest. In order to provide consistency for parents, students, and teachers, schedule changes will be kept to a minimum. Before making a request, please review the information below to assure that you fully understand the schedule change policy.

#### Requesting a schedule change:

In the rare event that a schedule change is needed, a Schedule Concern form **must** be submitted on the Nova Middle School website. Schedule Concern forms will be available at <u>novamid.browardschools.com</u> from 8/22/23 – 8/28/23. Requests may not be made through personal meetings, phone calls, or emails. Once the Schedule Concern form is provided to the School Counselors, the student's records will be reviewed, and a decision will be made regarding the request.

#### **Reason for changes:**

- · Student is missing a core class.
- · Student was inappropriately placed based on grade level.
- · Student was inappropriately placed based on skill level.

If a student received any of their elective choices from their Course Request form, no changes will be made.

#### **Other Requests:**

Nova Middle School will not change student schedules for any of the following reasons:

- · Friends are in another class
- · Lunch period preference
- · Unaddressed behavior or academic concerns

# **Unified Dress Code (UDC)**

All Nova Middle School students are required to follow the mandatory Unified Dress Code policy. Students must conform to the UDC during all regular school days, including Early Release Days. Students involved in school sponsored clubs/activities or sports must wear appropriate unified dress code attire or a school issued uniform on game/competition days only.

#### Clothing:

Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Skorts - Cotton twill "docker style" in hunter green, yellow/gold, black, white, red, navy blue, gray or khaki. No leggings/jeggings or any type of jean pants or corduroys. Shorts must be longer than the fingertips when held down the side of the body or mid-thigh.

Shirts - Collared "polo style" in any solid color. Nova Middle's PTSA sells Nova "Spirit Shirts" for each grade level. These Spirit Shirts may be worn on Fridays and are required attire for all field trips.

Picture ID's – Once student ID's are distributed, all students must wear them either by lanyard or clip.

Jackets - Jackets must be a solid color. Jackets must be worn with an approved uniform shirt beneath. Students are permitted to wear solid-color vests or cardigan sweaters with appropriate uniform shirt.

Shoes - Footwear must be worn at all times. Unified dress code requires close toed shoes at all times.

Winter Dress - If the temperature falls below 50 degrees Fahrenheit, students may wear jean pants that do not have holes and/or rips.

#### **Important Information**

- Undershirts may not hang beyond or below the uniform shirt. Undergarments that do not fit properly beneath the uniform shirt will be confiscated.
- NOT ALLOWED: Pants that are knit/lycra, spandex, parachute, athletic, fleece, denim and corduroy material of any type or color, hip huggers, or lowriders. Sweatpants or sweat suits are not allowed. Shorts/skorts/skirts that are above mid-thigh as described in the Secondary Code of Student Conduct; Section III are not allowed.
- Sleeveless shirts and shirts without collars are not allowed.

- Clothing which is too tight or oversized does not conform to the Unified Dress Code.
- Tops must be long enough to cover the complete mid-section when arms are held up overhead.
- Tank tops, tube tops, etc... that show beneath the uniform shirt are not permitted.
- Bottoms may not have any writing across them.
- Also inappropriate are chains, spikes, headbands, bandanas, gang paraphernalia; tattered clothing (clothing must be hemmed); midriffs; unbuckled pants; long dangling earrings, curlers, shower caps, hats or caps; suspenders, slogans, emblems, motifs, stripes, or patterns in clothing.

#### **PTSA Sells Spirit Shirts**

Nova Middle's PTSA will be selling Nova "Spirit Shirts." Spirit Shirts may be worn on Fridays and are required attire for all field trips.

Consequences for non-compliance to UDC Policy will be aligned with the Broward County Secondary Discipline Matrix. Parents are encouraged to ensure that their children adhere to Nova Middle's Unified Dress Code Policy.

- The Welcome Center will open at 8:45 AM.
- Students may not be signed out after 3:45 PM.
- The Welcome Center will close at 4:00 PM. The main telephone line will be answered from 9:00 AM until 4:50 PM.

#### **On Early Release Days:**

- The Welcome Center will open at 8:45 AM.
- Students may not be signed out after 1:45 PM.
- The Welcome Center will close at 1:45 PM. Staff will be available in the Student Services Department until 4:00 PM. The main telephone line will be answered from 9:00 AM until 4:30 PM.

#### **On Teacher Planning Days:**

• Office hours are from 8:00 AM until 3:30 PM.

# **Classroom Interruptions Policy**

Please be advised that homework, P.E. clothing, field trip money and miscellaneous deliveries are not accepted in the main office. The only items that may be dropped off or delivered to students are eyeglasses or preauthorized medication to the nurse. Lunch money may be deposited directly to a student's account in the cafeteria. Parents should report to the main office to sign in and receive a visitor's pass to visit the cafeteria.

# **School Supplies**

During the first week of school, each of your child's teachers will provide them with a syllabus, which contains information about the class, teacher contact information, and supplies needed for class. Until you receive the supply list/requests, send your child with basic supplies such as: paper, pencil, pen, and a folder to keep important handouts in.

# **Daily Schedule**

Our students have a total of 8 classes. We are on a 4 class per day block schedule; We call it our Odd/Even calendar. On Odd days students will attend class periods 1, 3, 5, 7, and on Even days students will attend class periods 2,4,6,8. Our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students go to lunch with their 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> period teacher. Our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students go to lunch with their 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> period teacher. The odd/even calendar for 2023-24 will be posted on our website the week before school starts.

#### **Bus Information**

All Nova students that live at least 2 miles or more from the school and within Broward County are eligible for a bus through Broward County Schools Transportation. If you need transportation for your student, you will need to register through the transportation website during **the first week of August**.
