#### HERITAGE AND CHARACTER TRAIT OF THE MONTH






November is Native American Heritage Month

#### TRANSITION NIGHT AT THE QUEST

The Quest Center hosted its annual Transition Night on Thursday, November 2, 2023. Transition Night aims to provide parents of students with disabilities (ages 12 and older) with personalized time with community service providers. District, county, and state service providers share pertinent information about guardianship, community agencies, adult day training (ADT) programs, and community resources that will aid in students with disabilities' transition from school to community. During Transition Night, parents schedule tours to view ADT programs, learn of community/ agency program availability, complete applications for Vocational Rehabilitation, and meet with Guardianship Attorneys. Transition Night provides parents of students with disabilities with the knowledge and guidance needed to ensure their children and families are prepared for a successful commencement after exiting Broward County Public Schools. BCPS prepares ALL our students for meaningful postsecondary experiences.
