The practice of turning the clocks forward one hour from Standard Time during the summer months and back again in the fall is known as Daylight Saving Time. The fundamental concept is that putting the clocks forward one hour in the spring allows us to make better use of natural daylight during summer evenings, while changing the clocks back one hour in the fall allows us to make better use of natural daylight during winter mornings.

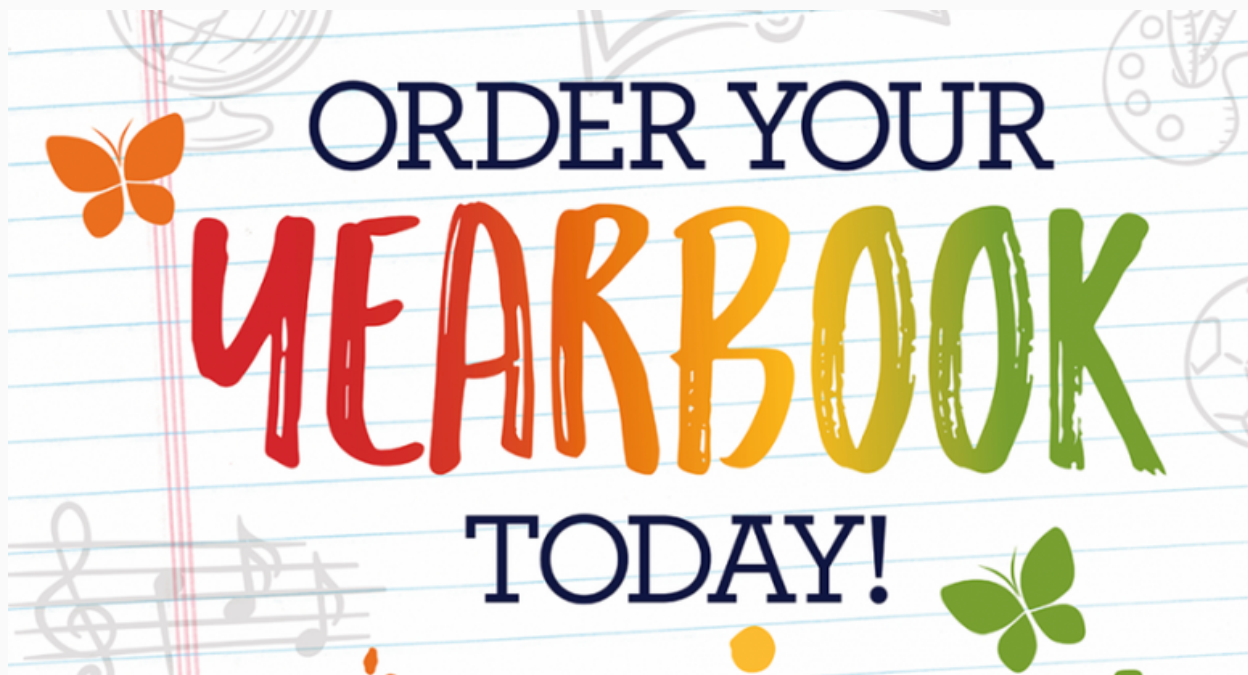
Sports
