HOW TO APPLY TO ATLANTIC TECHNICAL COLLEGE AND TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL Entrance requirements for incoming 9th, 10th or 11th grade students:

- Students must have a Level 3 in FSA Reading and Mathematics as determined by your prior year scores. If the FSA is unavailable, a recent, norm-referenced standardized test must be provided demonstrating a minimum score at the 50th percentile in Total Reading and Total Math.
- Students must have a GPA of 2.5 in the academic core classes (English, Math, Social Studies and Science) on their most recent report card.
- A limited number of seats may be available for students in grades 10 & 11. High School transcripts and standardized test scores must be reviewed to determine eligibility.
- No seats are available for 12th grade
- Buses are provided for students living more than two miles from the school and reside north of Sunrise Boulevard.
- No applications are accepted at the school as per School Board policy.
- Students who have never attended Broward County Public Schools MAY NOT apply online.
