Dear Senior Parent/Guardian:

Graduation is just around the corner! I congratulate you on this special milestone and look forward to a dignified and sophisticated ceremony. This year's graduation ceremony will take place at the Don Taft University Center at Nova Southeastern University on May 31, 2019, at 9:00 A.M. Graduates are expected to arrive at 7:00 A.M. Doors will open to the public at 8:00 A.M. Each family will receive a total of six (6) tickets for family members who wish to attend the graduation ceremony, including those with multiple siblings graduating. This number is based on the size of the senior class and the number of seats available. All family members and friends, including infants, must have a ticket to enter.

Parking will be available for graduates and guests in Nova Southeastern's Library Parking Garage. Each vehicle must purchase a parking pass by Sunday, May 26, 2019 for \$7.00 in order to park. Passes can be purchased through Broward County's electronic payment system (estore.browardschools.com/OSP/default.aspx).

The Don Taft University Center enforces all their facility rules. Inappropriate behavior may result in immediate removal from the ceremony. Diploma plaques will be available for purchase after the ceremony. Professional pictures are taken during the graduation ceremony and will be available for purchase during the summer. Please refrain from flash photography.

Graduation rehearsal is **MANDATORY** and is scheduled for Wednesday, May 29, 2019, in Nova High School's Cafeteria at 4:00 P.M. As a reminder, in order to receive a standard diploma, students must have the appropriate 24 credits, complete an online course, maintain at least a 2.0 unweighted grade point average, pass FSA ELA Reading, pass FSA Algebra EOC, and complete 40 volunteer service hours, among other requirements.
