# THEME: SHAPING PEACE TOGETHER

## PARTICIPANTS

Broward County Public Schools students grades 1-12 are encouraged to express their vision of *shaping peace together*.

## RULES

Participants may use a variety of mediums to express their vision of peace. Note chalk, charcoal and pastel entries should be sealed with a fixative spray to prevent smearing. Do not laminate entries. Three dimensional entries will not be accepted. Nothing may be glued, stapled or attached to the artwork in any way.

Poster artwork must be no larger than 11 inches by 17 inches. Digital Photoshop entries must be submitted on DVD in a .jpg, .jpeg or .gif format. Files submitted may not be larger than 10 MB. Please submit a high-resolution file (at least 300 dpi at 3,000 pixels.)

Only one entry per student. All artwork must be the individual student's original creation. Duplications will not be accepted. All artist signatures/initials should be written on the back of the poster.

## SUBMISSION

**DEADLINE: JANUARY 15, 2021**

**WINNERS WILL BE NOTIFIED BY: APRIL 15, 2021**

**A "20-21 Poster Contest Submission Form" must be included with all entries.**

Digital entries must be packed inside an envelope with the entry form securely attached to the envelope. Artwork that includes photographs of students must have authorized release forms signed by the parent/legal guardian of each child pictured.

Posters will not be returned and will become the property of Choose Peace/Stop Violence. Entries may be used in public forums.

Refer to "20-21 Poster Contest Submission Form" for complete guidelines to submit artwork. Form must be completed by teacher/school staff/organizer and must be securely attached to the back of the poster/DVD.

## AWARDS

**3 winners will be selected; (1) Elementary, (1) Middle and (1) High School**

Winning entries will be featured in the 2021-2022 Choose Peace campaign.

The school/organization where the winning entries originate from will be awarded a PEACE POLE.

Winners will receive a gift card prize valued at \$100.
