

The School Board of Broward County, Florida New Graduation Requirement (beginning 2021-2022) High School Money Matters: Personal Financial Literacy

Students who entered ninth grade in the school year 2021-2022 or after will be required to earn a 0.5 credit in Personal Financial Literacy to graduate from high school.

The Personal Financial Literacy course will engage students in content that includes learning the ideas, concepts, knowledge, and skills that will enable them to implement beneficial personal decision-making choices; to become wise, successful, and knowledgeable consumers, savers, investors, users of credit and money managers; and to be participating members of a global workforce and society.

**The following courses qualify for the Personal Financial Literacy High School Graduation Requirement based on a review by BCPS Staff (This list is valid only for students who entered ninth grade in the 2021-2022 school year and the 2022-2023 school year. The list may change for the 2023-2024 school year and beyond after the State of Florida Department of Education completes a review of equivalent courses):

- Personal Financial Literacy (Course #2102372)
- Personal Financial Literacy Honors (Course #2102374)
- Personal Financial Literacy (CTE Course # 8500120)
- Personal Finance (CTE Course # 8815120)
- An Equivalent Dual Enrollment course (Ex: FIN 2100)

Students who entered 9th grade prior to school year 2021-2022 <u>are not</u> <u>required</u> to earn a 0.50 credit in Personal Financial Literacy in order to earn a high school diploma.
