Powder Puff Rules

- I. Teams
 - a. Teams must consist of eight (8) minimum players at the start of the game and no more than eleven (11) on the field at one time. Both teams must have matched squads.
 - b. All players must be dressed in coordinated colors based on the year you are graduating (Shirts will be provided by SGA).
 - c. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
 - d. No jewelry can be worn at anytime while on the field.
 - e. Each team must designate one Captain to represent the players of that team.

- II. Play of the Game
 - a. Equipment
 - i. Each player must be wearing a set of flags. (Provided by SGA)

 - b. Game Clock
 - i. The games will be 20 minutes duration (Running Clock). There will be no half time periods.
 - ii. Each team will be allowed two (2) 30 second Time Outs per game.
 - iii. Over time periods will consist of five (5) minute period where the first team to score will win the game. The play will begin on the 30-yard line.

 - c. Play
 - i. The ball is considered DEAD if it is dropped during a play. (NO FUMBLES)
 - ii. There will be no intentional contact permitted, but screen blocking will be allowed.
 - iii. To down a player you must pull the opposing teams flag(s) and hold it above your head for the official to call the play dead.
 - iv. First Downs will be awarded to teams that gain 10+ yards during their possession of the ball.
 - v. The teams possession will consist of four (4) downs to get a first down if they fail to do so, then the ball will be turned over to the opposing team at the last line of scrimmage. NO PUNTS will be allowed.
 - vi. There is no illegal forward passing.
 - vii. There is no illegal participation on offense as well as defense.
 - viii. There is no stripping of the ball.
 - ix. Initial playing will start on the 30-yard line.
 - x. There is to be no foul language on the field. If a player is reported they will receive one warning, and if a second report is initiated that player will then be removed from the game.
