Charity for Champions provides scholarships to young individuals based on an application and interview process that takes into account students' achievements in the areas of academics, leadership, mentoring, community service and sportsmanship. Additionally, the application process factors in a student's struggles to overcome unique life challenges such as financial or family hardships, health issues, and other special needs.

Scholarships are only open to students graduating in the class of 2022 from high schools in Broward County.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

Student must be enrolled and participating in interscholastic/ club athletics. (This is inclusive of athletic training, band, color-guard, dance and ROTC)

Student must have a minimum 3.00 weighted GPA. You may not round up your grade point average.

Student must have demonstrated good leadership skills and commitment to their High School.

Students are encouraged to drop in for individualized support!

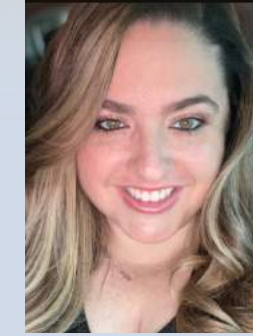

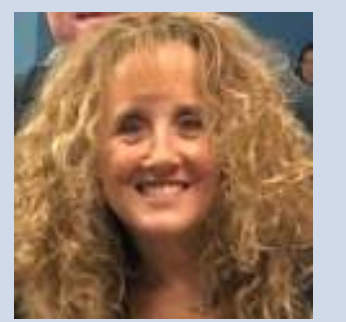
