### Theme: Book Your Trip: Adventure Awaits!

<b>Monday, January 27<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>"Trip Into Your Favorite Book"</b> Students and staff are encouraged to dress up like their favorite literary character. Students can use their imagination to decorate and "send" postcards to their favorite storybook characters.
<b>Tuesday, January 28<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>"Beach Trip"</b> Students and staff may wear beach attire and bring in a towel to lie on while they read or listen to a read aloud.
<b>Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>"Trip to Your Future"</b> Students can dress to represent a career they would like to have when they are older. Book selections for the day might include nonfiction reads about various career options. Door Decorating contest, "Look What Our Future Looks Like" theme (optional).
<b>Thursday, January 30<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>"Western Camp Out Trip"</b> Students and staff may dress up in western attire, bring their favorite books, sleeping bags or blankets, and flashlights to camp out in the classroom or library for their independent reading time. Classes may plan room campouts.
<b>Friday, January 31<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>"Hawaiian Trip"</b> Take your students to Hawaii for a luau party! Students may bring in some of their favorite books for a tropical reading celebration. They may also wear appropriate Hawaiian attire.

**Note: School appropriate attire must be worn at all times.**
