#### FIRST DAY PROCEDURES

Current AMS Eagles will receive their schedules on the first day of school during their first period class. Students' names will be posted along with their first period teacher so they will know where to go. Schedules are also available for previewing on Pinnacle. Please keep in mind that schedules are not final until the first day of school and that schedule changes may be made up until the 10<sup>th</sup> day of school as new students register and we make class-size adjustments.

We know the transition to middle school can be stressful for families, but we assure you that all of our teachers and support personnel will be on hand to assist your child with any issues they might be having.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All visitors must stop and share the purpose of their visit with the security at our front gate during the hours or 8:00 am to 3:25 pm. All visitors MUST be processed through our STAR security system when they arrive on campus for any reason. This includes assemblies, family nights etc.

Every student and staff member MUST wear an ID badge at all times while on campus and /or any school activity. Students will receive their first ID badge and lanyard for free. Consequences will be administered to any student who arrives to school without their badge.

Uniforms MUST be worn by all students at all times while on campus. PE Uniforms may be worn during PE time only.

No student may be on campus before 8:00 am or after 3:30 pm without a scheduled event planned with a supervising adult; for example, sports, after school program or clubs etc.
