Holiday Decorating Safety Tips

*All man-made trees must have flame retardant or flame resistant labels.

*If you have a natural tree, water it to keep it fresh and safe.

*Use a non-tip stand.

*Keep menorahs and kinaras at least three feet from flammable materials like curtains or decorations. *Do not overload outlets or use plastic adapters.

*Do not use any extension cords where the ground prong is missing from the plug.

*Candles or any open flames keep away from anything that might burn.

*Unplay all electrical decorations when you leave your home or go to sleep.

*Make sure your smoke alarm is working.
