It has been an honor to serve as your principal and I look forward to the great things that are to come in the 2024/2025 school year.

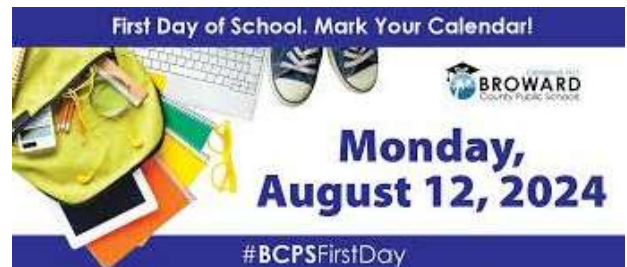

If your child will be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2024, it is time to register him/her for Kindergarten.

You need to bring in:

- \*original birth certificate
- \*official medical examination (Physical)
- \*official Florida Immunization (Form HD 680) shot records
- \*Two proofs of residence in the name of the parent/guardian registering the child:
  - \*1 current piece of evidence from the following: electric bill, telephone bill, lease or mortgage statement.
  - \*1 current piece of evidence from the following: Florida driver's license, credit card statement, bank account statement.

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Eligible students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year **MUST** register for a bus assignment. Use the webpage below to register and guarantee a bus assignment for the first day of school. Students who registered to ride last year (SY 24/25) but did not ride the bus last year must register using their student accounts (06 accounts).

Newly enrolled students to Broward County Public Schools need an assigned student ID prior to registering to ride. Please contact your school to get a student ID. It could take several days for your student information to populate in the transportation database (approx. 3-4 days).

**NOTE:** Programs such as ESE, 504, Foster, Homeless, and Teen Parent bus registration will continue to be processed by schools using Special Transportation Requests.
