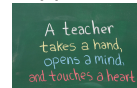

3. official Florida immunization (Form HD 680)
4. two proofs of residence in the name of the parent/guardian registering the child:

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: electric bill, telephone bill, lease or mortgage statement.

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: FL driver's license, credit card statement, bank account statement, or automobile insurance.

3. two proofs of residence in the name of the parent/guardian registering the child:

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: electric bill, telephone bill, lease or mortgage statement.

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: FL driver's license, credit card statement, bank account statement, or automobile insurance.

#### Out of County/Out of State/Private School/Charter School

1. original birth certificate or passport
2. official medical examination (Physical)
3. official Florida immunization (Form HD 680)
4. two proofs of residence in the name of the parent/guardian registering the child:

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: electric bill, telephone bill, lease or mortgage statement.

\*\*\*One current piece of evidence from the following: FL driver's license, credit card statement, bank account statement, or automobile insurance.
