

### Saturday March 28 Laptop/Device Distribution

Dear Broward County Public Schools Parents and Guardians,

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) will hold a second computer device distribution on Saturday, March 28, for parents and guardians who were unable to go to their child's school for the first distribution, or if the school ran out of laptop computers. Laptops may be picked up for student(s) in grades K-12 on Saturday, March 28, between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m.

For this second distribution, pickup locations will be limited to middle and high school locations only. For elementary and middle school students, please go to your local middle school for device pick up. High school students, please go to your local high school for device pick up. For students in combination K-8 schools, follow the direction for your specific school, which will be provided to you on a ParentLink sent by your principal. Devices will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis to those who need them.

**Please note, if your child is in grades K-5, you MUST go to your local middle school, NOT your child's home school to borrow a laptop. Distribution will not take place at elementary school locations on March 28. See distribution site locations below:**

- Parents may complete a BCPS Property Pass and send a legal adult who is already registered on their child's Emergency Contact List to receive a device.
- Parents who completed a BCPS Property Pass prior to the March 20 distribution are welcome to borrow a device if they were unable to receive one and still need a device for their child.
