You need to bring in:

- 1. Original birth certificate
- 2. Official medical examination (Physical)
- Official Florida immunization (Form HD 680) updated shot records
- Two proofs of residence in the name of the parent/guardian registering the child:
 - ***One current piece of evidence from the following: electric bill, telephone bill, lease or mortgage statement.

***One current piece of evidence from the following: FL driver's license, credit card statement, bank account statement, or automobile insurance.
