High School Voter Registration
Online Voter Registration Instructions for 2020

Step 1.


- Log on to your school's unique website.
- Click on the link: "Click here to begin your Voter Registration process"
- Complete the information page thoroughly and click submit at the bottom.
- If you do not complete the form, or leave fields blank, you will be instructed to complete the *Required sections.

Step 2.

- Click on the link at the top of your page to continue the registration process.
- View the welcome remarks and be sure to READ all instructions on the page.
- Be sure to have your Florida Driver License or Florida State issued identification card.
- Note: if you do not have either of these, you may still complete the required information. However, once you have completed the fields listed you will be prompted to PRINT the application. Any information that is not complete must then be given, including your signature. The application may then be mailed to 115 S. Andrews Ave, Ft Lauderdale, FL 33301. Attention L. Gema Morejón-White


Step 3.

- When entering the home address please be certain to follow the instructions specifically as written. The system will look for the address that matches your state-issued ID.
- First the screen will ask you for a zip code. Please type in the 5-digit code.
- The screen will ask for your house number: (here you are only going to write the number portion of your street address).
 - Example: If your address is 245 Lincoln Street, you are ONLY going to type, 245!
- Next, the screen asks you to provide the actual street name.
 Here you will type ONLY: Lincoln, and not the Street.
- The combination of those two fields completed should show a list of physical addresses for 245 Lincoln Street.
- Your screen should look like the picture below:



Step 4:

- Complete the remaining fields for your online registration.
- You will arrive at a completion screen once at everything is complete.
- If information cannot be verified, or was not entered correctly, this screen will display:



- You will have the opportunity to edit and fill in missing information. Otherwise you will have to print out the application and complete the form by hand.
- Once you've reached the end of the process you should receive your new Information Card within three (3) weeks by mail.
