Extended Learning Opportunities Program is an afterschool enrichment program offered through Broward County Schools at Westchester Elementary.

Westchester is pleased to announce our Wildcat Clubs. Wildcat Clubs are a part of ELOP, Extended Learning Opportunities Program. Students will participate in eight sessions. Clubs will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays beginning January 27th and will run for eight weeks; one session per week. Our clubs will be offered from 2:15-3:15 pm. Students will be dismissed at 2:00 and are to proceed directly to the cafeteria. Student supervision and snack will be provided from 2:00 - 2:15 p.m. The assigned club teacher will then come and pick up the students and they will proceed to their club.

Club teachers will then escort students out to car line for pick up at 3:15 p.m. Pickup is in the bus loop on 123rd Ave. All aftercare students will be dismissed back to the Aftercare program. A prompt pick-up by 3:15 p.m. is the responsibility of the parent. NO CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED TO WALK OR RIDE A BIKE HOME. There will be a late fee of \$15.00 (per child) for each 15 min increment after 3:30pm. The pick-up time is established by the Broward County School Board and MUST be strictly followed.
