

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How do I obtain Transportation?



If your child is registered in his/her school of attendance with the correct address information for the upcoming school year, and is eligible for transportation, bus card mailers have been mailed from the district since the first week of August.

How do I obtain Transportation?



If you do not receive a mailer, and you live more than 2-miles from the school of attendance and/or otherwise eligible for transportation, please call your school of attendance for further information.

Also, "newly registered" students may have to utilize an alternate method of transportation for up to 10 school days.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES


- > Students should not arrive on campus prior to 8:55 am.

METHOD OF ARRIVAL	PROCESS
School Bus Riders	Depart the Bus Loop
Walkers	Proceed on sidewalk on NORTH side of the building.
Car Riders	Proceed through Main Entrance
Bike Riders	Secure Bicycles on the NORTH side of the building

The District's face covering policy, which requires the use of masks in District schools and facilities, <u>remains in place</u>.




SAFETY GUIDELINES

The Before and After School Child Care Program is known as the Cove Academy. Our program consists of a morning session that runs before school from 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.


- ▶ The afternoon session runs after school, from 4:00 p.m. 6:00 p.m.
