## FAFSA Common Challenges

Not reading the definition of questions that FAFSA will ask the student that determine a student's dependency status.

Entering information on the FAFSA that does not match after student and/or parent have created their FSA ID.

Not understanding what parent information that the student needs to put on FAFSA – example if parent is "remarried" and at the time of completing the FAFSA the students legal parent and step parent will need to provide their information on the FAFSA.





# Who is a Parent?

□A legal parent includes a biological or adoptive parent, or a person that the state has determined to be your parent (for example, when a state allows another person's name to be listed as a parent on a birth certificate).

Grandparents, foster parents, legal guardians, older brothers or sisters, widowed stepparents, and aunts and uncles are not considered parents unless they have legally adopted you.

## IRS DATA Retrieval Common Challenges

IRS DATA Retrieval Tool – Reasons why certain tax filers cannot use the tool

- -Was a victim of identity theft
- -Married but filed their individual return as married filing separate
- -Married and filed as head of household



## FSAID Common Challenges

#### User Name and password mistakes common mistakes

Not having a direct match to the social security administration data base: Example using the correct name and social security number that is a direct match to Social Security Administration.

\*this can be avoided by having the most recent and current social security card in front of you when creating the FSA ID

Forgetting the FSA ID Username and or FSA ID Password – this can be avoided by not just writing it down but also saving it on a network device such as a cell phone.

Not using a "personal email address" when creating the FSA ID – one should never use their school email address or their work email address as it may not be an option to utilize if student and or parent needs to access that email and it is no longer accessible.

### COST OF ATTENDANCE VS. TUITION
















#### Create a New FSA ID

An FSA ID is a username and password that gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member.

You are not allowed to have an employee or agent of a commercial entity, or other third party, create an FSA ID for you for any purposes including but not limited to: payment reductions, debt consolidation or applying for aid. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

Important: When you are done, select the CANCEL button to clear your data even if you did not finish creating your FSA ID. Just closing your browser window or going to another website may not be enough to prevent other people using this computer from seeing your information until the session expires.

Estimated Expected Family Contribution (EFC) = 005928
The EFC is a measure of how much you can contribute to the cost of your education. Schools use your EFC to determine your federal student aid eligibility.

The EFC is not how much aid you will receive or how much you have to pay for college.

Based on the eligibility criteria, you may be eligible for the following:

Direct Stafford Loan Estimate - \$5,500.00 You may also be eligible to receive other federal. state, or institutional grants, scholarships, and/or work-study.

In addition, you should learn about federal tax benefits for education, including the American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC).

Your parent(s) indicated that they had filed an IRS tax return when they provided their financial information and it appears that they were eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, which allows them to transfer their IRS tax return information directly into your FAFSA. The benefit of using the tool is that it's the easiest way to provide accurate tax information, and it also eliminates the need for providing a copy of your parents' tax return to the financial aid office at your college. Once your FAFSA has been processed, you can return to FAFSA on the Web and your parent(s) can use the tool to transfer their tax information.
