

Main Idea: noun

The most important or central thought of a paragraph or larger section of text, which tells the reader what the text is about

Focus: Who, What Where, When, Why & How

• Theme: noun

The authors attempt to teach the reader a valuable lesson through text's theme. Theme in fiction is not explicit or literal, it's something the author implies.

Focus: A universal message that teaches the reader about life

Symbol: noun

Using an object or action that means something more than its literal meaning.

Focus: Double levels of meaning; universality

• Perspective: noun

An attitude toward or way of looking at something. A point of view.
