The Student Tutoring And Resource program (STAR) will provide students an opportunity to excel in their courses through this after school extended learning opportunity.

IMPORTANT: ALL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN STAR MUST HAVE AN AUTHORIZATION FORM SIGNED BY THEIR PARENTS/ GUARDIANS TO ATTEND.

Days:

- S.T.A.R. will be **every Tuesday and Wednesday**. Please note that we will not have S.T.A.R. the week of mid-terms and final exams and before Thanksgiving and Spring Break.
- S.T.A.R. will begin: **November 1, 2023**

Calendar:

- Calendar will include the teachers name and the courses being tutored by that specific teacher.

Time:

- Students must report to the media center **between 3:00-3:15**.
- After 3:15, students must bring a pass. The pass must include **students name, date, time, organization, and signature from sending faculty/ staff member**.
- **Students will NOT be admitted late into S.T.A.R. without a pass.**

What you need:

- School issued ID.
- Parent approval form for the first visit.

Sign-In:

- Students need to sign in, by grade level and must include their **student number and the specific course** they will be working on (ex: Algebra II, Chemistry Honors.)
- Or use our QR Code.

During S.T.A.R.:

- Please sit at the designated tables assigned to your subject area.
- Students must follow school rules. Therefore, **disruptive behavior will not be tolerated**, and students will be immediately removed.
- Computers are to be used for online courses, research, and classroom assignments only.
- Students are not allowed to wander throughout the media center.
- All areas of the media center, including the side lab, will be used for designated subject areas.

Consequences for disruptive behavior in STAR:

- 1st Offense: Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Two-week suspension from S.T.A.R.
- 2nd Offense: Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Four-week suspension from S.T.A.R.
- 3rd Offense: If there is a third offense, you will not be permitted back to S.T.A.R.

Leaving S.T.A.R.:

- You must **sign out** of S.T.A.R. if you need to leave before 4:45.
- Students who leave S.T.A.R. before 4:45 must have their own transportation home and exit campus immediately. A bus pass will not be issued to students who leave early.
- If you need an Activity Bus Pass, then students must remain in the media center until 4:45.
- Activity Bus is only available to magnet students who live 1.9 miles from campus.
