- S.T.A.R. will be every Tuesday and Wednesday. Please note that we will not have S.T.A.R. the week of midterms and final exams and before Thanksgiving and Spring Break.
- S.T.A.R. will begin: November 1, 2023

Sign-In:

- Students need to sign in, by grade level and must include their student number and the specific course they will be working on (ex: Algebra II, Chemistry Honors.)

During S.T.A.R.

- Please sit at the designated tables assigned to your subject area.
- Students must follow school rules. Therefore, disruptive behavior will not be tolerated, and students will be immediately removed.
- Computers are to be used for online courses, research, and classroom assignments only.
- Students are not allowed to wander throughout the media center.
- All areas of the media center, including the side lab, will be used for designated subject areas.

Consequences for disruptive behavior in STAR:

- 1st Offense: Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Two-week suspension from S.T.A.R.
- 2nd Offense: Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Four-week suspension from S.T.A.R.
- 3rd Offense: If there is a third offense, you will not be permitted back to S.T.A.R.
