Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival begins at 7:15 am each day. Only faculty and staff will be granted access to the campus prior to 7:15. Gates will be locked prior to and immediately following arrival and will not open again until just prior to our 2:00 pm dismissal. While waiting in line, please be careful not to block the driveways in the neighborhood. Follow the car line to the back for students to enter/exit the car. Please do not have students enter or exit the car on the side streets. Parents must remain in your car when picking up a car rider. Students will NOT be dismissed from the cafeteria door.

ID Badges/Lanyards

Late Arrivals and Early Dismissals

Students who arrive to school after 8:00 am must be brought to the front office and signed in by the parent or guardian. Parents who wish to pick students up prior to the 2:00 pm dismissal must come to the front office no later than 1:30 pm with a state issued photo ID. Anyone without ID and not listed on the Emergency Contact Form will not be allowed to pick up the student. ALL dismissal changes must be made in writing. We cannot accept dismissal changes over the phone or after 1:30 pm.
