Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival begins at 7:15 am each day through the car loop and at 7:30 for our students walking to campus. Only faculty and staff will be granted access to the campus prior to 7:15. Gates will be locked prior to and immediately following arrival and will not open again until just prior to our 2:00 pm dismissal. While waiting in line, please be careful not to block the driveways in the neighborhood. Follow the car line to the back for students to enter/exit the car. Please do not have students enter or exit the car on the side streets. Parents must remain in your car when picking up a car rider. Students will NOT be dismissed from the cafeteria door.

Late Arrivals and Early Dismissals

Students who arrive to school after gates are locked at 8:00 am must be brought to the front office and signed in by the parent or guardian. Parents who wish to pick students up prior to the 2:00 pm dismissal must come to the front office no later than 1:30 pm with a state issued photo ID.

Anyone without ID and/or not listed on the Emergency Contact Form will not be allowed to pick up the student. ALL dismissal changes must be made in writing prior to 1:30 pm. We cannot accept dismissal changes after 1:30 pm.
