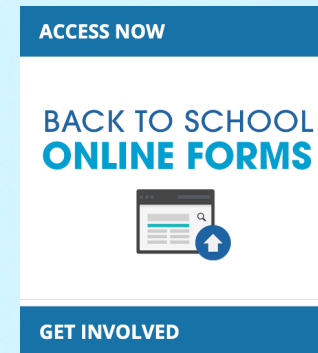

Important Arrival and Dismissal Reminders

School Times: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. First Bell - 7:50 a.m.

Students are not permitted on campus before 7:30 a.m.

There is no supervision before 7:30 a.m.

All Kindergarten through 5th grade car riders are to be dropped off for arrival on the EAST side or back of school. The WEST Parking lot (front of school) is for district school buses, private transportation vehicles, and staff members. The school has special permission for A-Team & VPK students to be dropped off for arrival in the front parking lot.

All car riders (including VPK, A-Team and General Education Students) are to be picked up for dismissal on the EAST side or back of the school. Parents need to enter the car line via 9th Street.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping everyone at Panther Run Elementary School Safe.

Dress Code

Panther Run has a mandatory school unified dress code.

All students attending Panther Run must adhere to this unified dress policy. Uniforms can be purchased through the school-approved dealer or at a local department store. The unified dress code consists of navy blue or khaki colored pants, skirts or shorts. Girls may choose to wear skorts or jumpers in these same colors. Polo shirts in navy blue, hunter green, or gray will be worn. The Panther Run PTA school tee shirt can also be worn. Cargo pants are not permitted. Students are permitted to wear jeans that fit properly and are not torn. Loafers, closed shoes or sneakers may also be worn. More information on school uniforms is available in the school office. Parents can apply for a waiver to the school uniform policy within the first ten days their child is enrolled at Panther Run, or within the first ten days of the beginning of every school year. Waivers are available in the front office. Student identification badges are part of the dress code and must be worn at all times on campus. Students are not permitted to wear suggestive, revealing or indecent clothing; including but not limited to clothing that exposes private body parts and/or displays pictures or words that have a sexual connotation. Hoodie sweatshirts, leggings and hats are not allowed to be worn in school.

News from Food & Nutrition

School breakfast & lunch are free for Panther Run Elementary students

Thanks to federal, state and local partnerships, Food and Nutrition Services are able to offer variety and well-balanced nutritious meals. The National School Lunch Program provides the student the opportunity of selecting a lunch consisting of 5 meal components (Meat/Meat Alternate, Milk, Grain, 2 fruits or vegetables). The student may choose 3, 4, or 5 components for the same price. A student may refuse 1 or 2 of the meal components. The idea of “3 are good, 4 are better and 5 are best” is promoted to assure the greatest variety and nutrient intake. School lunch meals provide an assortment of foods including entrée salads and fresh fruit daily. For students who prefer to bring a bag lunch, either low fat white, strawberry or chocolate milk, or water are available for \$.50 per carton. Ice Cream will be sold on Wednesdays for \$1.00. If a student does not select 3 of the 5 components offered as a meal, then the meal does not qualify for federal reimbursement and the student must pay ala carte prices. Students are charged a la carte prices for additional portions and for specialty items. Because of the government’s support, choosing the school lunch meal is a real bargain. Please see the list of ala carte items and prices on page 21 of this newsletter. A couple items on the list will be sold daily based on availability. Under the Universal Free Lunch Pilot program, all students at Panther Run Elementary School will be receiving lunch for free. Breakfast is free District-wide for all students.

We are highly encouraging parents to apply for the free & reduced meal benefit program this year. Students will bring home a Free and Reduced Price Meal application the first week of school. The United States Department of Agriculture provides free or reduced price meal to children whose families meet income requirements. This helps assure that all children have access to nutritious food during the school day. Children need proper nutrition to grow, be healthy and learn. Only one application is necessary per household. Information is secure and confidential. Non-citizens and non-residents may apply for benefits. Step #1: REGISTER

- Go to www.sunshinefl.com/schools-we-serve/ to begin your child's Sunshine After Care registration.
- Review the payment schedule for your child's school location and click on the red "REGISTER HERE" button. It will then transfer you to The School Board of Broward County's registration portal. Select your child's home school and complete the registration. If you receive an "error" message when entering your child's student id number, please go back and select that you DO NOT have your child's student id number.
- You will receive an email from BASCCSunshine@browardschools.com once your child's registration has been submitted. Do not reply to this email as it is an automated email and is not monitored.

Step #2: WAIT FOR ACCEPTANCE & APPROVAL EMAILS

- Sunshine will then review your registration and will "ACCEPT" it within 3 business days – acceptance notice will be sent via email from "Broward Schools". Due to high volume of registrations, it may take longer than 3 days. If your child's registration cannot be accepted because it requires additional information/documents, you will be emailed or called. If you are requested to complete a Medication Request Form, it can be found on our website, www.sunshinefl.com. Please email completed form to info@sunshinefl.com, make sure to include your child's full name and school location.
- Upon receipt of your "Broward Schools" acceptance email, Sunshine will enroll your child in "EzChildTrack". EzChildTrack is our SECURE online parent portal for you to make payments, enroll in autopay, print/view statements, invoices, receipts, year-end tax statements and register your child for future Teacher Planning Day Camps, Holiday Camps and Winter/Spring Camps. Once your child is enrolled in EzChildTrack, you will receive an "APPROVAL" email from Sunshine approving your child's enrollment.
- If you currently DO NOT have an EzChildTrack account, you will also receive an email with a temporary password to sign into your account (use the BLUE sign-in section using the primary account holder's email and your temporary password). If you have not received the email with your temporary password, please go to the EzChildTrack website, www.ezchildtrack.com/sunshineasc/parent/ and click on "SIGN UP". Once you have entered the primary account holder's email address a temporary password will be emailed to you.

Step #3: MAKE A PAYMENT

- Once you have received your final approval, go to the EzChildTrack website, www.ezchildtrack.com/sunshineasc/parent/ and sign into your account (under the "SIGN IN" section) to make your registration fee payment. A receipt will be emailed to you each time a payment is made.
- Period #1 tuition WILL NOT reflect on your account until July 29th. If you are ready to make your payment prior to July 29th, under the "Payment & Statements" section, click on "pay now" and enter the amount that you would like to pay under "other amount". As of July 29th, your account will be invoiced for period #1 and the amount will appear under the balance owed section. Refer to your child's school payment schedule for tuition amount.
- Payment schedules can be found on our website, www.sunshinefl.com/schools-we-serve/. To view your rate per period, click on "VIEW/ENROLL" on your EzChildTrack account.
- In order to secure your child's spot, your registration fee payment is due within 24 hours of receipt of the approval email. Tuition for period #1 is due no later than July 29th. Failure to make the registration fee payment and period #1 payment on time, your student will be withdrawn and their after care spot will be forfeited. If you are enrolled in autopay, your payment will be processed on July 29th.

Step #4: READY TO START SUNSHINE!

- Students that have been approved AND fully paid by July 29th can begin Sunshine After Care on the first day of school. An email with an approved start date along with important information pertaining to your child's school location will be sent by Friday, August 9th.
- Students registered AFTER August 1st will be placed on HOLD and may start Sunshine After Care on or after August 19th (IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE). If your child's school does not have space, your child will be placed on a Waiting List.
