## School Advisory Council Minutes for May 22, 2024

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### **Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Panther Run Elementary School Advisory Council was held in Pembroke Pines, FL on May 22, 2024. Co-Chair Janet Delgado called the meeting to order at 2:27. P.m. Mahalia Henry will record minutes for this meeting. 15 committee members are present.

**1. Approval of Minutes:** The first item on the agenda is approval of minutes from the meeting held on the April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Ms. Thompson motions to approve the minutes, Ms. Wetstein 2<sup>nd</sup>. All were in favor; minutes approved.

## School Advisory Forum Minutes for May 22, 2024

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**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Panther Run Elementary School Advisory Forum was held in Pembroke Pines, FL on May 22, 2024. Janet Delgado called the meeting to order at 3:24p.m. Mahalia Henry will record minutes for this meeting.

**1. Approval of Minutes:** Mrs. Delgado's refers to the minutes from the forum meeting held back in January 2024. Ms. Hadley motions to approve the minutes, Ms. Wetstein 2<sup>nd</sup>. All were in favor. Minutes approved.

**2. Updates from District Meeting 5/15/24:**

Mrs. Yvonne Howard, our SAF chair, shared information from the the May 15, 2024, South Area Advisory meeting:

- a. Redefining Schools: Mr. Alan Strauss spoke about the Redefining Schools and recapped the Town Hall meetings held through out the county. He spoke about the previous night's meeting at Plantation High School. He reiterated that there will not be any school closures for the 2024-2025 school year. It will be a planning year for the upcoming changes of 2025-26 school year. The potential consideration for schools is to change grade level configurations, lease or sell school properties, change school boundaries, private/public partnership, merge/combine schools, repurpose school, or close schools. The recommendation mentioned for Panther Run is a program shift from Silver Shores Elementary. Panther Run would take in their ESE population, and they would become a K-8 open choice school. Our current utilization is 47.8%; if the program shift occurs the projected utilization would be 65.3%.
