SUBJECT: UNIVERSAL FREE LUNCH PROGRAM PILOT

The Food and Nutrition Services Department is piloting the Universal Free Lunch Program in 47 Non-Community Eligibility Provision (Non-CEP) Schools for the 2023/2024 school year. The Universal Free Lunch Program Pilot provides reimbursable lunch meals to students at no charge, regardless of their eligibility. The Universal Free Lunch Program Pilot will begin August 21, 2023, and end June 10, 2024.

To sustain the Universal Free Lunch Program Pilot, it is vital for parents to complete an online application for claim reimbursement and to provide opportunities for additional District programs.

Attached is the Parent Link script for principals to be sent Monday, October 2, 2023, to encourage parents to complete a Meal Benefits application.

Also included is the Letter to Households which is to be posted on the school's District website.

A monthly reminder Parent Link script and letter for the school's website will be sent to reinforce the importance of Meal Benefits applications to sustain the Universal Free Lunch Program Pilot.

The goal of the Universal Free Lunch Program Pilot is to increase student academic achievement, while supporting student performance.
