Eligible test scores AND completed Recommendation Form are due online for J.P. Taravella High School by Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup>. This includes both the student and parent segments.

If you meet the unweighted GPA requirement of 3.0 but need qualifying test scores, please visit <https://www.broward.edu/academics/dual-enrollment/students.html> to create a BC account and complete a Testing Voucher Request Form. The placement chart is also listed at this link. Please keep in mind that test scores are only valid for 2 years.

**Student Deadline:** Thursday, February 9, 2023

**Registration Begins:** Wednesday, March 1, 2023

Some Important Reminders:

- **All students participating in Dual Enrollment for Summer 2023 are only allowed to take 1 course this summer.**

The Dual Enrollment Program at Broward College (BC) is an accelerated program that allows eligible public/charter, private and home school secondary students to take postsecondary coursework and simultaneously earn both high school and college credits, saving both time and money! Dual Enrollment students are exempt from the payment of application fees, tuition, and laboratory fees. College courses are offered at BC campuses and centers, including the Broward College Online campus, and at several high school campuses.
