ICC Ethics Contract

It was voted amongst the ICC Executive Board that the following rules and consequences become effective for the 2021-2022 school year. All club officers must abide by these policies:

- 1. If any officer posts inappropriate pictures on a website (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, etc.) that shows the student in possession of ANY illegal substance or partaking in any illegal activities, the club sponsor has the right to remove the officer from their position.
- **2.** An external suspension will result in an officer's immediate removal from their position.
- **3.** Students caught cheating, accompanied with a teacher referral, will result in removal from office.
- **4.** An officer with excessive detentions (5 or more) CAN be removed from office. The decision is up to the club sponsor.
- **5.** Any officer on the school attendance sanction list CAN be removed from office. The decision is up to the club sponsor.
- **6.** If any officer is involved in any form of cyber bullying, administration has the right to remove the officer from his/her elected position.
