#### Testing Schedule

- ✓ If a student has technical difficulties on the day of the exam, he/she will need to contact College Board directly. There should be a link in the student's exam of where to contact.
- ✓ We want to encourage students to take their exam on the normal scheduled test date. If for some reason, a student misses the window for general testing, the student will receive a notification from College Board to test in the make- up window. After the make-up window, there is no other test date.

Students may not consult with others

Comprehensive and strict set of protocols to prevent and detect cheating, including but not limited to:

- Students required to verify identity and confirm work is their own on test day
- Student work provided to their teachers after testing
- Plagiarism detection software

Students trying to gain an unfair advantage will have their scores canceled, and their school and potential colleges will be notified





#### Uploading a Screenshot of Submitted Exam

- ✓ Students will need provide their AP Teacher proof that they completed the exam.
  - Have them take a screenshot of the submission page when they complete and submit the exam.
  - Create an assignment in canvas for them to upload the screenshot –
     This way it's a consistent on how we are tracking these results.
  - Please make this a grade in your gradebook to ensure students follow through.
- ✓ Once the students have submitted this assignment send the results to <a href="mailto:Matthew.Winans@browardschools.com">Matthew.Winans@browardschools.com</a>
  - This information is pertinent for students who did not take the exam so we can prepare for the June makeup window.



Things to do Before Exam Day for Students

- 1. All students MUST be able to log into their College Board account linked with their AP Classroom and that their College Board account is up to date.
  - If they forgot their password, please have them click "Forgot Password". If that still does not work, they will need to call the Student Helpline to reset it. 888-225-5427
- 2. It is important to note that students must be able to receive outside emails to the email address they've provided. These emails will come from: <a href="mailto:collegeboard@e.collegeboard.org">collegeboard.org</a>. I will follow up with AP teachers on Monday, you should have received an e-mail communication with a link that will allow you to see whether or not students received and opened the e-mail.

  - Deadline to send your free score report is June 20, 2020
    - Log into your College Board account.
    - II. Click My AP Profile
    - **III. Click Score Send**
    - IV. Search the College/University name
    - V. Hit Save

- ✓ Have students log-in to their <u>College Board account</u> and verify their email address. In addition, please encourage students to add their cell phone number to their account and allow College Board to text them.
- ✓ Ask students to complete the AP student survey that was sent out the week of 4/13. This survey was included with the e-mail students received regarding their AP exam schedule. Please note: the survey will not have an impact on students' registration status. Students' registrations remain intact.

## AP Art and Design Digital Submission Updates for Students

#### **Digital Submission Updates**

#### Here are a few reminders:

- No physical portfolios: All AP Art and Design Portfolio Exams will be submitted digitally. There will be no physical portfolios this year.
- New submission deadline: May 26, 11:59 p.m. ET
- · Updated number of works:
  - Sustained Investigation: 10 images (instead of 15)
  - Selected Works: 3 works (instead of 5)
    - AP 2-D Art and Design and AP Drawing: 3 images (1 view of each work)
    - AP 3-D Art and Design: 6 images (2 views of each work)



# AP Art and Design Digital Submission Updates for Students

There are also changes to some steps students will take in the <u>AP Art and Design digital submission web application</u>.

- Setting up the portfolio: To initially create their portfolios in the web application, students need an access key from their AP teacher or AP coordinator. You can find your access key on the Tools page in the AP Art and Design digital submission web application. If you aren't able to provide students with your access key, they can use this one: aps2020. However, if students don't use your specific key, you won't be able to review their work in the web application.
- Placeholder images: Although there are fewer required works this year, the
  web application still requires students to upload 15 images to the
  Sustained Investigation section and images of 5 works to the Selected
  Works section. Students must upload their images only to Sustained
  Investigation spaces 1–10 and Selected Works 1–3. These are the only
  images that will be scored. For the remaining spaces in each section,
  students need to upload placeholder images, which can be found on this
  page. If students already uploaded their own placeholder images, they
  don't need to reupload new ones.



# AP Art and Design Digital Submission Updates for Students

- Acknowledge physical portfolios and printed written evidence: For AP 2-D
  Art and Design and AP Drawing, to proceed in the web application students
  still need to check the boxes that say they'll mail their physical work,
  including printed written evidence. This is only a technical requirement.
   There are no physical portfolios this year.
- Confirming portfolio status: The demo encourages students to sign back in to the web application after they've submitted their portfolio to ensure their teacher didn't send it back to them for any reason. Students' portfolios must be in one of the following statuses at the time of the May 26, 11:59 p.m. ET, deadline in order to be scored: Forwarded to Teacher, Forwarded to Coordinator, Forwarded to AP. Since you might have limited ability to contact your students this year, we urge you not to send a student's portfolio back to them unless absolutely necessary.
