

1<sup>st</sup> Offense = Warning/Green Sticker

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense = Warning and/or Phone Call Home/Green Sticker

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense = 30-minute detention/Green Sticker

4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Offense OR failure to serve 30-minute detention =  
1-hour detention/Green Sticker

6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Offense OR failure to serve 1-hour detention =  
Saturday School/Green Sticker

8<sup>th</sup> Offense OR failure to serve Saturday School =

| <b>(Figures below are calculated over a school year)</b> |                |
| 5 minutes late each day                                  | 3 days lost!   |
| 10 minutes late each day                                 | 6.5 days lost! |
| 15 minutes late each day                                 | 10 days lost!  |
| 20 minutes late each day                                 | 13 days lost!  |
| 30 minutes late each day                                 | 19 days lost!  |

### **Danger:**

As few as 19 missed days over the school year reduces your child's chances of success.  
Your child's SATs or results could drop by one grade across ALL subjects!
