



COCONUT CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL – TRAFFIC ISSUES

ATTENTION: Parents, guardians, caregivers, and anyone transporting children to and from Coconut Creek Elementary School.

The Coconut Creek Police Department is responsible for ensuring the safety of all students and the community. However, a significant increase in vehicles transporting students to school has presented several new traffic challenges throughout the 2022-2023 school year.

This notice is intended to educate drivers on the types of actions that are contrary to Florida State Traffic Laws before the Coconut Creek Police Department is forced to conduct stricter enforcement. In order to maintain the safe flow of traffic, it is essential that everyone obeys the following stipulations:

- Lining up, parking or stopping of any kind on the roadway, prior to 2:30 PM, is strictly prohibited
- Do not block the intersections or any portion of the crosswalks in the area
- Do not block driveways
- Do not block exits/entrances to communities
- Do not enter neighboring residential communities or businesses to park, awaiting 2:30 PM dismissal time
- Do not park on the grass swales of neighboring communities. This practice leads to property damage
- Do not stop in the roadway to pick-up or drop-off students

ANY VIOLATION OF FLORIDA STATE STATUTES WILL RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF TRAFFIC CITATIONS.
