Drop Off/Pick Up

ID Badges

We will be setting up a schedule for all classes to receive their badges. Parents/guardians we need your assistance in ensuring this badge is on the student each and every day. If your student utilizes a wheelchair, you may either place the badge on the student or on the chair in a visible location.

As you are aware, our perimeter gates are only open during entry and dismissal times. If you are coming to the school during the school day, you will be either greeted by security at the gate or it will be necessary for you to call the school number for entry.
