 - Select the teacher/staff member to email

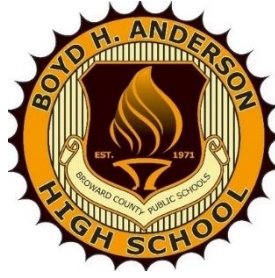
2. Where can my student log in for **Distance Learning Online**?

3. How will **attendance** be taken? How will students receive **grades** for Distance Learning?
 - Students are expected to long-in to Canvas daily through Single-Sign On in order to be counted for attendance (sso.browardschools.com).
 - Teachers will be updating Canvas pages on a weekly basis. You can check Canvas and Pinnacle for updated grades.
 - The last day of Quarter 3 is April 1st.
 - Quarter 4 will begin on Monday, April 6th.

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5. Who can I contact about **graduation requirements**?

- **Current seniors:** If a senior has **not met** the criteria for Algebra I EOC (End of Course) Exam and/or Grade 10 ELA FSA, or earned a concordant score, this criteria will be waived.
 - Current seniors must still earn the necessary credits and meet the GPA requirements to graduate.

- **Non-seniors:** Students in an EOC course will be required to take the associated EOC and meet the assessment graduation requirement. Students who have yet to passed the Grade 10 FSA ELA must still meet the exit criteria by passing that assessment during a future administration or earning a concordant score.

 - The SAT administration on May 2, 2020, has been canceled.

 - All ACT test administrations in April and May have been canceled.

 - Advanced Placement examinations will occur under modified test administration conditions and modified test design. Students will take the examination at home and the examination will be completely free response. That means only essays and problem-solving prompts, with no multiple-choice questions. Students have been preregistered by the College Board and will be contacted by the College Board and their classroom teacher with further directions. 9. Are IB students still taking the **International Baccalaureate** examinations?
 - International Baccalaureate has canceled examinations for Spring 2020. Course credit will be determined by the local teacher.
