Notice - All 12th Grade Students

As you are aware, schools will be closed until May 1, 2020. Please see the **VERY IMPORTANT** information below regarding graduation status and graduation requirements.

<u>Graduation Testing Requirements:</u> All testing requirements (Reading and Algebra) that were previously required to earn a standard high school diploma have been waived for students who are graduating during the 2019-20 school year.

<u>Community Service Hours for Graduation:</u> Community service hour requirements are waived for graduation this school year. If Students still have service hours to turn in, students are encouraged to turn them in anyway. Students are also strongly encouraged to find ways to contribute to their family and community in ways above and beyond regular responsibilities and chores. Students who are able to provide community service through physical efforts or digital means should maintain a record of the time and the product/contribution for submittal upon return. <u>Online Requirement:</u> At this time, students are not required to complete the online requirement as they as currently engaged in online learning through Canvas.

<u>Graduation Requirements:</u> All seniors are still required to meet the current graduation requirements in order to receive their diploma. This includes passing all core classes and maintaining a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Students should know their requirements and regularly monitor their progress toward earning a diploma. School counselors are available to assist students with planning for college and career readiness. Students can view an up-to-date report of their progress toward meeting graduation requirements on Virtual Counselor.

<u>Course Recovery:</u> Seniors who failed a core class previously must completely recover that course in order to receive a diploma. Students who are currently enrolled in recovery either through FLVS or night school must make sure that they are meeting the expectations as stated by FLVS or night school.

<u>Attendance:</u> All students are expected to log into **ALL** their classes **DAILY** to verify attendance. Please note that the attendance policy and expectations are still in place. In order to be marked present you will need to log in via Single-Sign on. This can be done by accessing Clever.
