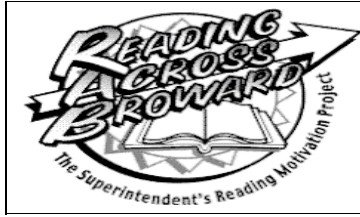


## AR 80

Accelerated Reader is a program to motivate students to become independent readers while enhancing their comprehension. The children read books then take computerized comprehension tests based on the knowledge of the book. Students receive points based on the test and comprehension percentages. The goal is to have an 80% comprehension rate by May 21<sup>st</sup>. In addition, students will be recognized by their accumulated points. There will be no top point earners this year.

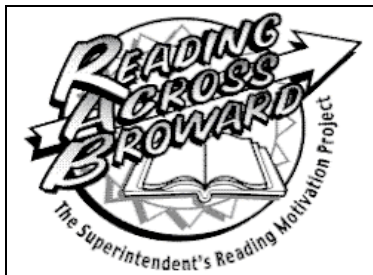
