For the safety of all students, students should not be on campus before 7:30. Supervision begins at 7:30.

Per District policy, students cannot be dismissed 30 minutes prior to dismissal. (1:30 school days and 11:30 early release days)

Riverglades welcomes and encourages parents to get involved. However, parents must apply online to become a volunteer. The approval process takes about a week, so please plan accordingly. Anyone wishing to volunteer, chaperone field trips, attend class events, or be in the classroom and attend parties must be an approved volunteer. Your photo ID will be scanned the first time you visit the school; for each return visit, you must give your name and show your photo ID to receive a badge for the day.**

If your child needs medication, please pick up a medical authorization form from the front office. It must be completed by a doctor and updated annually. Medication can't be administered without the completed form.



Riverglades offers a School Board operated After Care program from 2:00 – 6:00. Students participate in a variety of activities including cooking, music, outdoor, computers, academics, and homework. The cost is \$212 every 18 days. There is also a registration fee of \$30.00 per student. Early release days are included. If you do not pay on time – we must charge a re-registration fee of \$30.00 per child.

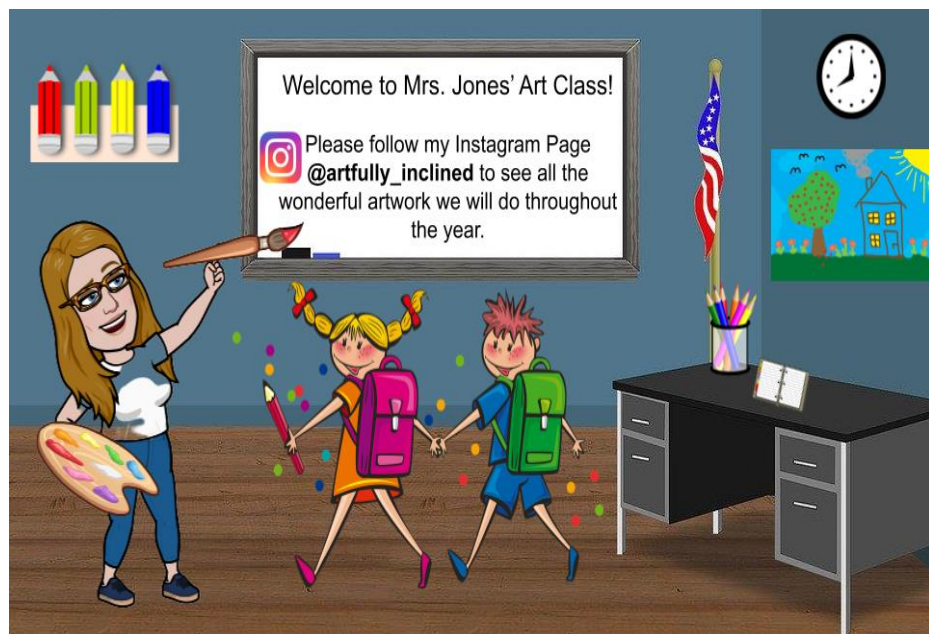
If you join PTA by Monday, August 16th - you will receive a free homework pass. The pass will be available for pick up in the cafeteria during meet and greet.
