SUBJECT: COMMERCIAL FOOD DELIVERY SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

Unauthorized visitors are not allowed on the property of Broward County Public Schools for the delivery of student ordered commercial meals. Administrators must enforce all campus safety procedures for the benefit of the entire school community.

A variety of commercial food delivery services, such as UberEATS™, allow the use of mobile phone applications to place orders from local restaurants with food items being delivered to the requested location. High school students have attempted to utilize these services to have "takeout food" delivered to their school during the school day.

Broward County Public Schools are closed campuses. Students are not permitted to order food items to be delivered to school campuses. School personnel are not permitted to accept commercial food deliveries for students.
