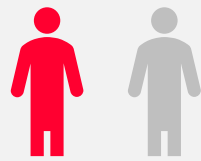

*Current 9th and 10th graders are the first cohort to not have the option of the PERT exam to satisfy their Algebra 1 EOC Graduation Requirement.

**Students must now pass the Algebra 1 EOC (with a level 3) or score highly enough on the SAT (420), PSAT/NMSQT (430), or ACT (16) in order to graduate.

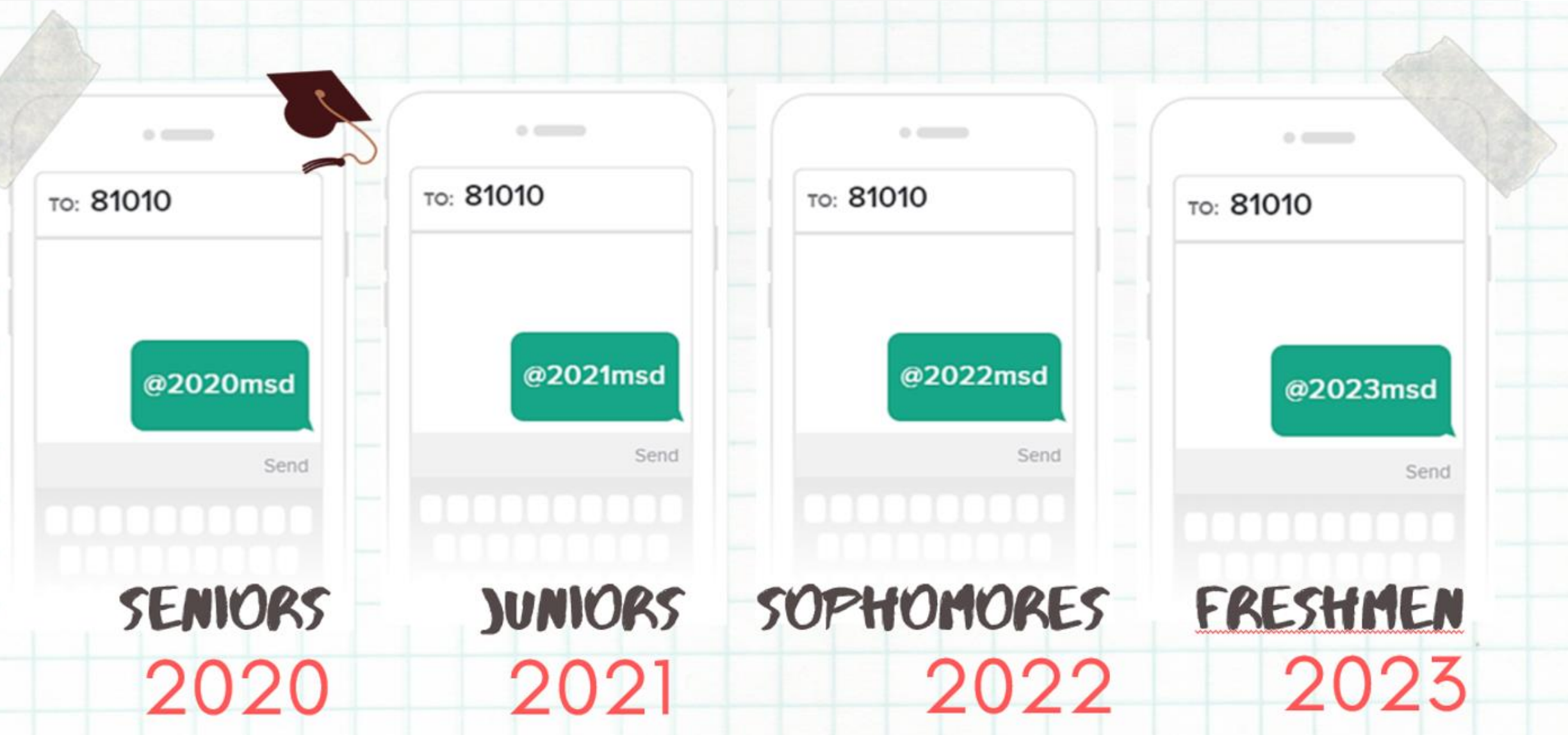
