

North Area Transportation



All eligible students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year MUST register for bus assignment.

Use the webpage below to register for a bus assignment for the next year. Private Schools, Charter School, and new registering students entering the Broward County Public School (BCPS) system, that are eligible for transportation can register starting June 13, 2022.

Newly enrolled students to Broward County Public Schools, eligible for transportation, need an assigned student ID prior to registering to ride. Please contact your school to get a student ID. It could take several days for your student information to populate in the transportation database (approx. 3-4 days).

Eligible students registered by July 15th will be augranteed a bus for the first day of school.





Schedule Change Process

- Schedule Change Request Forms: The forms for course changes will be given out during 1st period on the first day of school. Core class changes will be the first priority.
- Fill out the form completely and accurately.
- Deadline to submit a schedule change request is Thursday, 8/18 – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Response will be provided by your form being returned to your 1st period class with either a new schedule if a change is granted or a denial.
- Please be aware that online systems take 24-48 hours to update a change.
