

## ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE AN ID TO ACCESS CAMPUS (NO EXCEPTIONS).

- IDs must be worn at all times while on campus.
  - Temporary ID stickers are issued to students who forget their ID. At the 5<sup>th</sup> sticker, you automatically get a reprint and will be charged \$5 as an obligation. Each sticker after 5 will incur a \$1 obligation. If it continues, progressive discipline will be issued starting at the 7<sup>th</sup> sticker.

## **No Commercial Food Delivery**

School personnel are not permitted to accept commercial food deliveries for students (this includes services such as Uber Eats). Broward County Public Schools are closed campuses. Students are not permitted to order food items to be delivered to school campuses during the school day.





#### LATE TO SCHOOL

If your child is going to be LATE for school, please call Student Services at (754) 322 – 2163 **BEFORE** the student arrives on campus.



Then the student can pick up their LATE PASS in Student Services if it is after 8 am. Excessive lateness (more than 4 a quarter) will result in progressive discipline/intervention, regardless of it being an excused or unexcused tardy as per the discipline matrix.

#### ABSENT FROM SCHOOL

If your child is going to be **ABSENT** from school, please call our hotline at: (754) 322 – 2152 or fill out the online absence reporting form (linked here) within 48 hours of the absence. For all other attendance issues, please call the school directly at (754) 322 - 2150.

#### EARLY SIGNOUTS

If you want to dismiss your child from school using their own transportation or authorize an adult not on your emergency list to pick up your child, write us an email including a copy of the registering parent's Drivers License, phone #, name of the student, time of dismissal, and method of transportation to:

### SIGN-INS

- □ Tardies to 1st and 5th period can be excused by a parent/guardian in person or via phone call 754-322-2163.
- □ Over 5 sign-ins, whether excused or unexcused, may be referred to administration for a possible pattern of non-attendance and documentation may be required: doctor's note and/or court documentation.

#### SIGN-OUTS

Students may be signed out by a parent/guardian in person or by email: <u>SDHSIGNOUT@BROWARDSCHOOLS.COM</u>. Students are ONLY allowed FOUR (4) sign outs per quarter via email. Once you've utilized your FOUR (4) sign outs by email, a parent/guardian (or someone on the emergency contact card with permission to release a student) MUST come in person to our Main Office to sign a student out.

#### SENIOR PARKING/PRIVILEGE & THE 10-10-10 RULE

Beginning this year, we are following the 10-10-10 rule. If you exceed 10 absences OR 10 sign-outs OR 10 tardies to school ANY YEAR (9-12), you will NOT be eligible for SENIOR PRIVILEGE OR A SENIOR PARKING DECAL when you reach senior year!

## **BUS ASSIGNMENT** Anyone Needing a Bus Must Register with Register2Ride



## GET REGISTERED

All eligible students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year must register for a bus assignment. Use: <u>https://tfsweb.browardschools.com/ride</u> to register and guarantee a bus assignment for the first day of school.

Any student who registered for a bus last year and did not use the service, must register for a bus using their student 06 account.

Eligible students registered by July 7, 2023 will be guaranteed a bus for the first day of school. Eligible students registered by July 21, 2023 will be assigned no later than second week of school.

Any registrations after July 21, 2023, will be routed expeditiously in the order in which they were received.





Student Transportation & Fleet Services

Eligible students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year MUST register for a bus assignment. Use the webpage below to register and guarantee a bus assignment for the first day of school. Students who registered to ride last year (SY 22/23) but did not ride the bus last year must register using their student accounts (06 accounts).

Newly enrolled students to Broward County Public Schools, need an assigned student ID prior to registering to ride. Please contact your school to get a student ID. It could take several days for your student information to populate in the transportation database (approx. 3-4 days).

NOTE: Programs such as ESE, 504, Foster, Homeless, and Teen Parent bus registration will continue to be processed by schools using Special Transportation Requests.



There are important updates that we encourage you to review with your student.

#### We have highlighted (2) two important updates below.

- ✓ Fights: any fight on campus will result in 9 days of external suspension.
- Publishing on Social Media: any situation that can compromise the safety of students, staff, or property (a fight, a threat, vandalism, etc.) must be shared/reported immediately to school administration using the following appropriate means:
  - 1. Report directly to administration
  - 2. Call DSOC (District Security Operations Center) at 754-321-3500 24/7
  - 3. Send an email to securitytips@browardschool.com
  - 4. Submit a tip online via FortifyFL at GetFortifyFL.com
  - 5. Submit a tip through the Safer Watch app

If a student does not follow the proper reporting methods, and shares the information on social media or through messaging apps with friends, may be subject to disciplinary action.

#### Discipline presentations and assemblies will take place the first week of school.



#### House Bill 379 : Technology in K-12 Public Schools

Prohibits a student from using a wireless communications device during instructional time, except when directed by a teacher for educational purposes, and requires a teacher to designate an area for wireless communications devices during instructional time.
