## **Choose Kind, in the Car Line**

The car line can be long and very daunting at times. We ask that you practice patience and are courteous to your friends/neighbors that also utilize the car line. Please abide by the following policies:

- **Pull ALL THE WAY FORWARD**, this allows us to load and unload your precious cargo more expeditiously.
- Have your pelican **enter on the passenger side of the car**, it is extremely unsafe to allow your child to cross in a through lane.
- If you are the parent of a younger child, and **you want to buckle or unbuckle your child into the car, please PULL**

## **ALL THE WAY UP, and to the right to allow other vehicles to pass.**

- *Teaching your child how to open the door, unbuckle, and exit the car safely is an excellent way to teach our pelicans how to **Be Responsible and Be Safe!!!** It also fosters children's independence.*

If you'd like to help, please contact your child's teacher.

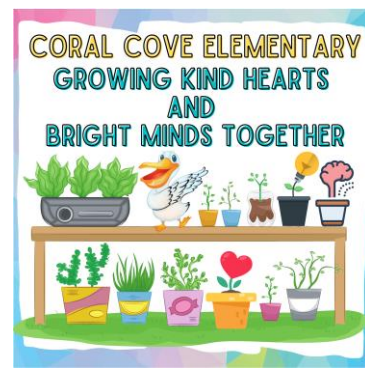
