Dear Parents.

We welcome you to Collins Elementary for an AWESOME 2020 - 2021 school year! It is certainly not like we had anticipated; nevertheless, we are e-Learning ready!!! As we enter this school year, please review our school's protocols for beginning our school year as outlined below. **As we progress through the year, some of these protocols are subject to change.** If you have any questions or concerns regarding these procedures, please contact the main office or administration for clarification.

- Please complete all Back to School forms and sign up for Class Dojo messaging as soon as possible. Links for these items along with Immunization information are located on this Homepage.
- Student Resource and Laptop Distribution will take place on Friday, August 14 and Monday, August 17 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Please come to the school to pick up the student resource materials even if your child already has a student laptop. Students will need both student resource materials and a student laptop for academic instruction. Your child's daily academic schedule will be a part of the student resource materials so please be sure to pick up this important information.
- Since we are not meeting in the school building due to COVID-19, the initial parent contact will be made by classroom teachers. Classroom teachers will contacting students in their Homeroom class via phone call beginning Friday, August 14, 2020. In that phone call your child's homeroom teacher will introduce himself or herself and provide information for your child attend his or her Canvas class on the first day of school.
- SCHOOL STARTS ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19, 2020!! Please mark your calendars. Daily Attendance will be taken by your child's classroom teacher beginning August 19, 2020. Class instruction begins at 8:00 a.m. Your child needs to be logged into class by 8:00 a.m. The school day ends at 2:00 p.m. Your child will have academic instruction with breaks and lunch time from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
- Our Virtual Open House will be held on Thursday, August 20, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. We will present general information and then you will have a breakout meeting with your child's teacher. If you need a copy of the school supply list, it is located on this homepage.
- We are accepting visitors to the school campus at this time, and you may all the school with inquiries. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, protocols for school visits have been modified. It is imperative for visitors to do the following:
 - 1. All visitors must wear a mask while on the school campus. Social distancing (6 ft. apart) will be followed while on campus.
 - 2. If you need to register your child, please call the school to make an appointment. We will inform you of the documents you need to bring with you for that appointment to assist with limiting multiple trips to the campus.

- 3. If you are exhibiting flu-like symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14-21 days, please do not come to the school campus. Please contact us by phone at 754-323-5150 and we will address your concern.

We are here to work with our parents in the best interest of student achievement. Therefore, parent conferences will remain an integral part of academic achievement within the virtual environment.
