HERON HOBBIES

Heron Hobbies (ELOP) is an after-school enrichment program offered at Country Isles Elementary. All classes run for eight weeks and are taught by certified teachers. Online registration will take place February 24th-March 6th. Club space is limited to 15 children per class. If a club does not reach eight students, it will be closed due to low enrollment.

5. After you have paid at the \$\$ E-Store \$\$, you will find a link for online registration on the CIE homepage.

-Clubs run from 2:15-3:15 PM.

-From 2:00-2:15, your child will be supervised and will have the opportunity to eat a snack, work on homework, or change clothes for clubs (if needed).

-Aftercare students will be dismissed to their aftercare group location at 3:15 PM.

-All other students will be dismissed at the bus loop located on the west side of the school. Parents will need to exit their vehicles to sign their children out.

-There will be a late fee for children that are picked up after 3:30 PM. (It is \$15 for every fifteen minutes.)

-In the event of an unforeseen circumstance, a club may need to be cancelled for the day. Parents will be notified, and a makeup day will occur after the initial eight-week session.
